

It is confirmed by Ryan that all blood will be edible, but we will not be using packs that will be popped inside the mouth (it is a little Ziplock baggie with blood inside)

PREP 2 Little baggies with blood

PREP 4 Larger baggies with blood

PREP 1 pipette onto knife

PREP IV bag with blood

Act 1 Scene 1, pg. 4 – Bat Boy Bites Ruthie on their neck

- Ruthie (Hope) will have a blood pack in the pocket of their overalls and as they raise their hand up to their “bite” wound, they will grab the blood pack and squeeze it in their hand and wipe it across their wound as they reveal it to the audience.
- PREP: Preset larger blood bag in Hope’s overall pocket

Act 1 Scene 5, pg. 44 – Dr. Parker slices the neck of a goose and blood pours into the basin.

- A blood pack will be rigged inside one of the geese and that goose will have a magnetic attachment for its head to connect it to its body. Then Parker can slice the neck of the geese and pop the pack so blood will pour into a basin.
- PREP: fill the IV bag with watered-down blood using the squeeze bottle and preset inside the goose.
- CLEAN UP: empty the IV bag and rinse it out.

Act 1 Scene 6, pg. 54 – Dr. Parker breaks a rat’s neck and hands it to Bat Boy to drink blood out of.

- A blood pack will be placed inside the rat so that it can be popped and swallowed from.
- PREP: put a small blood pack inside the little pocket in rat (poke with pin right before it goes onstage).
- CLEAN UP: rinse the rat off in the sink (hand wash) and throw in the dryer.

Act 1 Scene 9, pg 78 – Dr. Parker slices the rabbit’s neck and blood gets on Bat Boys face as he eats it.

- A blood pack will be placed in a pocket in the rabbit, and it will squeeze onto Bat Boys face when it touches him.
- PREP: put a small blood pack inside the little pocket in the rabbit (poke with pin right before it goes onstage).
- CLEAN UP: rinse the rabbit off in the sink (hand wash) and throw in the dryer.

Act 2 Scene 1, pg. 90 – Bat Boy Bites Rick after the Revival

- Rick (Wes) will have a blood pack attached to his collar which can be squeezed and popped by Bat Boy as he goes into bite.
- It could also work that Bat Boy has a blood pack in his pocket and that is taken out by hand and physically squeezed to release blood.
- PREP: Preset larger blood bag in the pocket in Wes’ collar.

Act 2 Scene 2, pg. 112 – Bat Boy enters with blood on his face

- PREP: Blood will be smeared on Max’s face.

Act 2 Scene 6, pg. 127 – Parker slits his throat and stabs Bat Boy & Meredith in the backs.



Blood Tracking

V3 as of 11.19.2023

- Parker will squeeze the base of the pipette that is rigged onto the knife as he slits his throat to leave a trail of blood on his neck.
- There will be blood packs rigged in the backs of their shirts that could be popped by the pressure of Parker's palm
- PREP: remove pipette and fill it with blood and tape it back on.
- CLEAN UP: rinse out pipette and clean knife.
- PREP: Preset larger blood bags into the pockets in Jules' and Max's shirts.
